Benedem COVID-19 Response Guidelines

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COVID -19 School Protocol

As the number of infections in the local community increases due to the implementation of With-Corona, it is acting as a sporadic risk factor even within the school setting.

The government is practicing distancing according to the set standards, and Benedem acts accordingly to prevent and response rapidly by having the safety precaution guidelines and policies to mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 VIRUS.

For that reason, we ask that we all err on the side of caution, remain home if you have any symptoms, and access a test if you have any concerns. It is very important that we all work diligently to remain safe from COVID.

We thank you in advance for your vigilance in following the COVID-19 guidelines and maximizing the safety of our school to continue to ensure no in-school transmissions.

Symptoms Include

The **COVID-19 symptoms** include the following: fever, cough, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, pneumonia as well as fatigue, loss of appetite, phlegm, gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, etc), confusion, dizziness, runny nose, stuffy nose, hemoptysis, chest pain, conjunctivitis (pink eye) and dermatological conditions (skin problems).

COVID-19 증상에는 발열, 기침, 호흡곤란, 오한, 근육통, 두통, 인후통, 미각 또는 후각 상실, 폐렴 등이 포함됩니다. 피로, 식욕부진, 가래, 위장증상(구토, 구토, 설사 등), 혼란, 어지럼증, 콧물, 코 막힘, 혈청투석, 흉통, 결막염(핑크아이), 피부과 질환(피부 문제) 등 코로나 증상입니다.

Who is defined as a “접촉자” close-contact with a confirmed patient?

- between 2 days before the occurrence of symptoms of an estimated or confirmed patient and 14 days after the occurrence
- been in contact for more than 15 minutes within 1 meter of the estimated/confirmed patient.
- had direct physical contact of the presumed/confirmed person.
- stayed in a limited, closed space with an estimated/confirmed patient

Staff and students, identified to have been in close-contact with the confirmed patient through the epidemiological investigation should quarantine for 10 days under guidance of KDCA Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency regardless of symptoms. Close-Contact student/staff with must stay home and watch health conditions for the next 10 days until directed and released by KDCA.

Please read carefully and act accordingly.

- Remain home if your temperature is 37.5°C and above or if they have any COVID-19 symptoms listed above.
- Please check your child’s temperature in the morning before coming to school.
- Student should stay home if his/her members of your household have taken a COVID-19 test and are awaiting the result. This includes tests conducted for having COVID-19 symptoms, having had contact with a confirmed patient, for travelling internationally, or as a precautionary measure after having distant contact with a confirmed patient.
- Student should stay home if a resident of the household is in self-quarantine.
